If you to plan to be there Saturday evening, there will be a potluck Haystack/American Tacos supper in the Steely Creek Lodge. Ask Lilia what you should bring for the potluck.

Meadow View Inn: \$110/per night

Motel-type rooms complete with private baths, all linens, and individual heat/AC. Sleeps up to 4 people with two queen beds.

Cabin: \$92/per night

Equipped with 5 bunks that sleeps up to 10 persons, with mattresses, table, chairs, shower, toilet, sink, kitchenette and heat. Guests must bring their own linens and kitchen & cooking utensils.

Campground: \$39/per night (Tents or RV's)
